



Dear Parents and Guardians,

St. Anthony Catholic School has a uniform policy that must be respected by all families. The school does its best to enforce it, but it can be challenging. We need your cooperation.

Common uniform violations include:

- Students wearing non-uniform shoes. Students in grades 3-8 must purchase their shoes from Flynn & O'Hara. Boys wear black-tie oxford shoes. Girls may wear uniform, black oxford or Mary Jane shoes.
- Jewelry is not permitted to be worn. This includes rings, bracelets, and necklaces. Hoops are not allowed to be worn.
- The P.E. shirt must be worn on P.E. day.
- Students may not wear P.E. shorts in the fall or winter.
- There is an academic uniform and a P.E. uniform. Clothing items may not be used interchangeably.

Please review the attached uniform policy. It comes directly from the handbook. Your compliance with this policy allows us to focus on other important issues.

The uniform policy is not new nor has it been revised. If a change is needed please do so by Monday, October 30th. From this point on, a uniform infraction and a fine will be given.
